Save As dialog box opens so you can select the drive and folder where you want to

save the file and you can enter a filename for the new file.

If you open, modify, and then save an existing file, Save will save the file under the same name on the same drive and in the same folder. Save As, on the other hand, will open a Save As dialog box, and you have the option of saving the file under a new filename, in a different folder, on a different drive, or by using any combination of these options.

the desktop. The contents of the Recycle Bin remain there until the Recycle Bin is emptied. If you need a file that you have deleted, you can restore it, which means that it leaves the Recycle Bin and is placed in its original location. To restore a file or folder, you double-click the Recycle Bin to open it. When you see the file or folder you wish to restore, select it, and then choose Restore the selected items button in the Restore group on the Recycle Bin Tools Manage tab. It is important to note that items deleted from a

removable drive cannot be restored.
